DHCD for approval of Randy Pearce as the new BCAAC committee representative.

Old Business: ICC was looking for contributions from VPMIA for the upcoming conference to be held in New Jersey. VPMIA had previously sent \$500.00 to New Jersey. A motion was made and approved to send an additional \$2000.00 to ICC for the Meet&Greet, Opening Event and a magazine add. At the last Board meeting held on May 24th the Board approved a donation of \$1000.00 be sent to the Oklahoma disaster relief fund, but that money was never sent and it appears at this time they are not interested in receiving that fund. For now at least that has been scrubbed.

New Business: There was support requested from ICC candidates Alex Olszowy, Jim Brown and Allen Boswell. A motion was made and approved to send letters of support for these candidates. There was a motion made and approved to have letters of support sent for candidates Gilbert Gonzales and Dwayne Garriss even though there has been no request from these candidates. ICC Disaster Relief Training Institute has ask VPMIA to promote and assist ICC in getting the word out about the training in March 2014. There was discussion about a location for next years Summer School of Instructions. The General membership made a motion and approved the motion to have the Time&Place committee to look into the possibility of a new location for next year and bring their recommendation back at our next general membership meeting in Nov 2013.

ICC Report: ICC is now looking for a new CEO. ICC's budget is looking good this year compared to last year. Keep in mind that ICC offers scholarships as well as your state organizations. As of July 2013 electronic exam certifications will come from the 2012 codes, but will be accepting 2009 exams until December 2013. There is a big initiative by ICC for CDP access. ICC on line voting will start full fledge in November 2013. You will be able to submit a code change on line and have others look at it and receive comments. You will need an ICC account. Code hearings next spring will be held in Memphis Tennessee and will be there for the next two years. Virginia will be a test site for the ICC on line voting. This year is the 10th year anniversary for ICC. If you plan on going to the hearings in New Jersey please register ahead of time.

ICC Region VII: No Report. Their next meeting will be held in Hagerstown Maryland on September 19th and 20th.

Buildings. There will be a work group meeting on August 22nd which may have four or five plumbing or mechanical code changes. On December 16th final regulations will be done and will be waiting for the Governors approval. Manufactured home program now on line to get certified. Sandi Morris will be busy updating training material from the 2009 to 2012.

DPOR Report: The proposal to eliminate plumbing, mechanical and electrical ceu's was approved by the Board in April 2013. It was sent to the Governor and he approved it as well, however there will be public hearings before being final approved. Doug Murrow recommended that all VPMIA members keep sending letters to the board with their displeasure of the results and any data they may have as to why the ceu's should remain.

VPMIA Legislative report Ron Clements July 25, 2013

Big Thank you- The Cemetery association and their lobbyist thanked us for working with them on the cemetery related code changes. They greatly appreciated our cooperation and guidance with the state code change process. The work and cooperation offered by our members was beyond their expectations.

The final 2013 legislative session report is available on the VPMIA Web site.

There are a few issues being discussed by the Housing and Environmental Work Group of the Virginia Housing Commission:

The State Fire Marshal fee bills that failed to pass during the 2013 session (HB2140 and SB822) were discussed. The state fire marshal raised a concern about the BHCD not being timely and responsive to budgetary fee needs of the state FM office. DHCD provided a full list and timeline of all fee request regulatory changes. I do not expect any action by the Virginia Housing Commission on this issue this year.

An issue was raised by a private citizen constituency in the City of Alexandria regarding high rise buildings without standby power generators. After a severe storm last year some residents of high rise condominiums were left without a working elevator in their building while the power was out for an extended period of time. The constituents went to their delegate requesting a bill to require the retrofit of standby power generators into high rise buildings that do not have standby power (Note high rise at one time was 150 ft not the current 75 feet). The delegate did not sponsor a bill and instead brought the issue to the VHC. The VHC requested that DHCD put the issue on the agenda to be discussed during the 2015 state code update cycle.

The towns verses counties bills that failed to pass during the 2013 session (HB1574 and SB1239) were discussed. This issue came out of a disagreement between Leesburg and Loudon over enforcement of the VMC. Loudon enforces the VMC in the county but not the towns. The intent of these bills is to require counties to enforce the VMC in towns when the VMC is enforced in the county. The Housing Work group is working on a potential bill to help solve this issue. The state law is unclear regarding how VMC enforcement is to be handled regarding enforcement in towns when towns do not elect to perform the enforcement.

/PMIA Plumbing, Mechanical, and Fuel Gas (PMG) Board Report

July 2013

- The code development cycle continues for the ICC and the 2012 VUSBC. The group B code cycle (Admin, ICCPC, IEBC, IECC, IFC, IPMC, IRC, ISPSC, IWUIC, and IZC) committee action nearings are complete and the report of the hearings where posted May 31st, 2013. The group B public comments are due for submission by July 15th, 2013 and the public comment agenda will be posted on August 28th, 2013. The group B public comment hearings will be held on October 2-10 in Atlantic City, NJ.
- The VPMIA/VBCOA PMG committee met face to face on June 14th, 2013. This meeting was held to establish which proposed code changes this group would be submitting public comments on. Based upon the outcome of this meeting and some follow up emails 23 public comments will be submitted on behalf of the VPMIA/VBCOA PMG committee. Another meeting will be held to review the public comment hearing agenda once it is published on August 28th, 2013 in preparation for the public comment hearings. A portion of this meeting was used to discuss 2012 VUSBC changes and the next ICC code development cycle, Group C (IGCC).
- The 2012 VUSBC code development process continues. The next combined workgroup meeting is being held on August 22nd, 2013. Following this meeting a second combined workgroup meeting is scheduled for October 11th. The Board of Housing and Community Development (BHCD) committee meeting will be held October 28th and the BHCD approval of the final regulations is slated for December 16th, 2013. - Scholarship update As of this writing a total of seven applications have been received. One of

 on the day of the membership meeting on current status of the applications.

- The VBCOA board of directors meeting was held on July 19th, 2013 in Amherst County.
- The VBCOA Region Chairs are in the process updating the VBCOA strategic plan and have also updated the job descriptions for the Second Vice President and the Sargeant of Arm which will be presented to the BOD for approval at the fall conference.
- VBCOA scholarship for Atlantic City public comment hearings update Originally July 19th was
 the deadline however this is being extended to July 26th, 2013. The scholarship is being targeted
 to smaller jurisdictions and first time attendees.
- Education Legal Aspects of Code Administration August 23rd, 2013, Williamsburg VA
- VBCOA membership has reached the 1,000 persons mark.

- VBCOA Region V was awarded the Region of the Year and Region III received the merit award.
- Legislative Cemetery Association sends their thanks for help with the code changes they
 presented to the 2012 VUSBC. Legislator looking at a retrofit requirement for emergency power
 to serve elevators in older high rises. This came from complaints of residents in these buildings
 when there are power outages of longer durations.
- DPOR As of July 1st residential building energy analysts are regulated. Tradesmen certification issue update Conflicting reports that the issue of continuing education is now finalized. Several members questioned how this occurred with what appears to be a lack of legal procedure.
- The next VBCOA meeting will be the fall conference November 3rd thru the 5th in Front Royal,
 VA.
